Transcripts may be ordered online through [Parchment](#) using a credit card. Delivery options are “Send Now”, “After Degree is Awarded”, or “After Grades are Posted”. The cost for an electronic transcript is \$8 per transcript. Official transcripts are sent directly to a college, employer or other agency and bear the university seal. Description of Assignment 1:

Complete a paper describing one or more conference activities to be utilized in your work setting and show how it supports your instructional goals. (3 Pages minimum)

- Describe the learning outcomes expected from the participants in your work setting as a result of this instructional activity.
- Explain how you plan to measure the impact of this activity on the achievement level of your participants.

Attend a minimum of 4 hours/sessions during the conference. Indicate the session title on the Conference Log Sheet, sign in the box on the right of each session entry, total and submit with all assignment(s) on syllabus. (Log sheet attached to syllabus)

Description of Assignment 3:

Extend your learning by reading one research-based journal article relevant to Assignment 1. Explain how the article coupled with the session or sessions attended, will inform your classroom or school practices. Include link to article or attach article to review.
